Applications are invited from registered tea exporters for consideration of financial assistance under the Brand Promotion Scheme for promotion of Pure Ceylon Tea brands with Lion Logo in selected overseas markets for the year 2021/2022.

PRIORITY PRODUCT CATEGORIZATION

1. High Valued specialty teas.
2. Tea Bags
3. Tea Packets (less than 3Kg)
4. Ceylon Tea Brand Own Tea Shops or Houses

FOR WHOM

- i. Have contributed to the Promotion Fund.
- ii. Only Sri Lankan owned tea brands which have been registered in Sri Lanka by the Director General, National Intellectual Property Office (NIPO)
- iii. Have demonstrated their ability to implement an international marketing campaign to penetrate new markets, sustain / increase the share in existing markets or recover lost markets;
- iv. Existing brands and new/emerging brands are eligible for application.

50% matching grant up to a maximum of Rs.50million per brand per year. (Please refer Scheme Guidelines for more details)
