## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR DIRECT PLANTING AND INFILLING SCHEME FOR THE CORPORATE SECTOR & PRIVATE SECTOR ESTATES MORE THAN 10 ACRES - 2024

## Introduction:

A budgetary provision out of the levy collections for the year 2023 is being made available to be utilized as subsidy payments for the corporate sector and the owners of the estates who are having more than 10 acres of tea for direct planting for this year.

Please note that all private & corporate estates should be registered under Tea Land Registration of the section No.02 of Tea Control Act No 51 of 1957, prior to apply for this subsidy.

- 1.0 Method of application:
- (i) Regional Plantation Companies that are in valid legal possession of the estates are eligible to apply for subsidy assistance using the application in annexure I.(Form No. TC/DIRECT/2023). It is compulsory to provide all the information as required by the application form. Failure to furnish the required information will lead to rejection of the application. Duly completed applications should be submitted to the relevant Assistant Tea Commissioner of the area where the estates are located on or before 28<sup>TH</sup> February 2024. As the funds are limited, the applications will be entertained on a "First Come-First Serve" basis.
- (ii) A Separate Registration number and approval letter should be obtained from Tea Commissioner prior to commencement of direct planting activities. Application should be submitted according to the stages stipulated in paragraph 3 II and the Tea Commissioner's prior approval should be obtained for any deviations. Recommendation will be given by Regional Assistant Tea Commissioner for such application after having a separate field inspection.
- (iii) Only the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Regional Plantation Companies & the Owners of the estates are eligible to sign the application. If CEO of the company or Owner of the estate not signing the application, he should forward the application with a letter indicating the name, position and the signature of the person who has been authorized to sign the application and subsequent documents on his behalf
- 2.0 Method of payment of subsidies:
- (i) Application should be annexed with certified copy of the registered deed or lease agreement of the estate and the relevant survey plan prepared by a licensed surveyor. Relevant location where you intend to commence tea planting activities should be indicated in a manner where could be identified by the inspecting officer.
- (ii) The subsidy scheme is as follows.

Financial Assistance: Per Plant- Rs.55.00

Per hole - <u>Rs.20.00</u> Total - Rs.75.00

The maximum 12,500 numbers of plants are given per hectare. Therefore Rs.937, 500/- is granted per Hec. There is no upper sealing in planting extent.

All the steps should be carried out according to the TRI guide lines prepare in this regard.02Kgs of compost should be added to a hole before planting. The funds will be released according to the schedule given below.

- (iii) Once the application is received by the relevant Assistant Tea Commissioner, arrangements will be made to conduct the necessary inspections to verify the information in the application. After ratification by the Assistant Tea Commissioner, the application will be forwarded to the Tea Commissioner, who is the approving authority. Once the application is approved, relevant amounts of subsidies will be released to the applicant (CEO of the relevant plantation company or the owners of the estates more than 10 Acres of tea.)
- 3.0 The applicants are required to adhere the guide lines imposed by Tea Research Institute on Direct Planting activities.
- 4.0 Applicants are required to furnish true and accurate information and need to assist to the inspectors at the time of field inspection and whenever they are required additional information regarding the applications.

Providing false or information known to be false is a punishable offence under section 41 of the Tea Control Act No. 51 of 1957 as amended. Apart from been liable to furnished under the aforesaid act, providing false information will immediately disqualify the company from current and any future subsidy schemes and will be liable to refund any subsidies already paid. Such companies may also become liable to be punished under the penal code for the embezzlement of state funds.

- 5.0 If the applicant is unable to complete planting or maintenance of the field is liable to refund any subsidies already paid.
