## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR TEA REPLANTING AND NEW PLANTING WITH MECHANIZATION FOR THE CORPORATE SECTOR & PRIVATE SECTOR ESTATES MORE THAN 10 ACRES - 2025

#### Introduction: 1.0

A budgetary provision out of the Sri Lanka Tea Board funds for the year 2025 is being made available to be utilized as financial assistance for replanting and/or new planting for the corporate sector and the estates having more than 10 acres of tea. This subsidy scheme covers only the tea fields that use machineries for land preparation, composting, setting up suitable irrigation system (Drip or Sprinkler) planting of tea with double hedge row system to match the requirements of mortared/electrically/battery operated harvesters. Approved monetary support is Rs.725, 000.00 per acre. All the activities should be according to the guidelines of the Sri Lanka Tea Research Institute.

#### Method of application: 2.0

- Regional Plantation Companies and the owners of tea estates of more than 10 acres that are in (i) valid legal possession of the estates are eligible to apply for subsidy assistance using the application in Annexure I (Form No. TB/TC/TRSS/MEC/2025). It is compulsory to provide all the information as required by the application form. Failure to furnish the required information will lead to rejection of the application. Duly completed applications should be submitted to the relevant Assistant Tea Commissioner of the area where the estates are located on or before 15th February 2025. As the funds are limited, the applications will be entertained on a "First come first Serve" basis.
- Land should be registered with Sri Lanka Tea Board (SLTB) tea land registry (ii)
- A Separate Registration number and approval letter should be obtained from the Tea (iii) Commissioner prior to the commencement of replanting or new planting activities. The application should be submitted prior to start planting and the Tea Commissioner's prior approval should be obtained. Recommendation will be given by Regional Assistant Tea Commissioner for such application after having a separate field inspection.
- Only the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Regional Plantation Companies & the Owners of (iv) the estates are eligible to sign the application. If CEO of the company or Owner of the estate not signing the application, he should forward the application with a letter indicating the name, position and the signature of the person who has been authorized to sign the application and subsequent documents on his behalf.

#### Method of payment of subsidies: 3.0

Application should be annexed with certified copies of the registered deed or lease agreement of (i) the estate and the relevant survey plan prepared by a licensed surveyor. Relevant location where you intend to commence tea planting activities should be indicated in a manner where could be identified by the inspecting officer. Applicants should agree to utilize such planting fields as demonstration plots/knowledge disseminating sites as this is a new development of Sri Lankan tea industry. The subsidy payment will directly be made to the bank account number of beneficiary. The beneficiary should provide the bank details with the application.

- 4.0 (i) The subsidies will be released as per the following schemes based on the completion of each stages:
  - (a) Scheme Replanting/new planting of tea with composting, irrigation with use of machineries.

1. land preparation and soil conservation	On completion of operation	150,000.00
2. Installation of irrigation system	Prior to Planting	200,000.00
3. Planting after composting	On completion of operation	275,000.00
4. Maintenance after completion of first year	One year after date of planting	50,000.00
5. Purchasing of harvesting machine (One machine per applicant)	Prior to harvesting	50,000.00
	Total	725,000.00

- (ii) Once the application is received by the relevant Assistant Tea Commissioner, arrangements will be made to conduct the necessary inspections to verify the information in the application. After ratification by the Assistant Tea Commissioner, the application will be forwarded to the Tea Commissioner/Deputy Tea Commissioner (Development), who is the approving authority. Once the application is approved, relevant amounts of subsidies will be released to the applicant (CEO of the relevant plantation company or the owners of the estates more than 10 acres of tea).
- (iii) Subsidy for purchasing of harvesting /plucking machine Applicants are eligible to receive subsidies for one harvesting machine per 10 acre and subsidy will be paid after producing of bills and proof documents to the SLTB. 2<sup>nd</sup> machine will be subsidized after planting more than 20 acre of land by a single owner under this subsidy scheme.
- (iv) The applicant should enter in to a Memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Sri Lanka Tea Board prior to commence the project.
- 5.0 Those lands intend to undertake direct planting activities should obtain a prior approval from SLTB and composting should be done prior to planting.
- Some applications received in 2024 for the above project have not been approved due to financial constraints. The necessary approvals will be granted for the applications received for the year 2024 under this subsidy scheme 2025.
  - (i) Applicants are required to furnish true and accurate information and need to assist to the inspectors at the time of field inspection and whenever they are required additional information regarding the applications.
  - (ii) Providing false or information known to be false is a punishable offence under section 41 of the Tea Control Act No. 51 of 1957 as amended. Apart from been liable to punished under the aforesaid act, providing false information will immediately disqualify the land owner or company from current and any future subsidy schemes and will be liable to refund any subsidies already paid. Such land owners or companies may also become liable to be punished under the penal code for the embezzlement of state funds.

- If the applicant is unable to complete planting or maintenance of the field is liable to refund any 8.0 subsidies already paid.
