SUBSIDY ASSISTANCE TO FORM A FACTORY BASED TEAM OF SMART TEA PLUCKERS (DALU TEAM) AND RENTING MECHINERIES FOR HOLING, PRUNING, AND LEAF PLUCKING - 2025

1. Introduction:

Acute scarcity of adequate number of skilled workers for field practices in tea land specially for land preparation, planting, leaf plucking and pruning etc is a burning issue in the tea industry .Further plucking is the most labour- intensive and costliest field operation which is around 70% of the total labour use.

In order to minimize the effect of the skilled labor scarcity, Sri Lanka Tea Board (SLTB) has initiated a subsidy scheme to form a team of trained workers for field practices and providing machineries and necessary items to maintain a tea machinery renting place at the factory level.

Budgetary provision is available to be utilized as subsidy payment to registered tea manufacturers, who agreed to maintain a sets of machineries for renting and a team of smart leaf pluckers for the year 2025 and those who received subsidy, should maintain the team and machinery renting facility minimum for a 3-year period.

2. Method of Application

- I. Registered tea manufacturers or Regional Plantation Companies (RPC'S) are eligible to apply for this subsidy scheme.
- II. Duly completed application (Form No.TB/TC/STPT-2025) should be submitted to the relevant Assistant Tea Commissioner of the area or to Tea Commissioner, Sri Lanka Tea Board, 574, Galle road, Colombo 03 on or before 15th February 2025.
- III. Only the Chief Executive Officers of Regional Plantation Company's and Registered tea manufacturers are eligible to sign the application. In the case, Chief Executive Officer or Registered tea manufacturer is not signing the application, they should furnish a letter of authorization to sign the application and subsequent documents on his/ her behalf

3. Procedure of team formation, purchasing machineries and renting out machineries.

- Applications are entertained on first come first serve basis since the budgetary allocation is Rs.35 million for the year 2025. The selected factories are allowed to choose a team of field workers/ employees/ youths willing to undergo a training program and work as tea technician. The age limit should be 18–45 years and a team should comprise 10 to 15 workers/candidates.
- II Five days' training is given to the selected team. The training sessions are arranged by the Sri Lanka Tea Board through NIPM with the assistance of TRI and TSHDA. Both theoretical and practical sessions on key field practices such as land preparation, weeding, planting, applications of agrochemicals, leaf plucking, and pruning will be covered and integrated with manual and mechanical means.

- III Plucking shears, battery operated plucking machines, plucking baskets and uniforms are given to the plucking team and deployed in field operations on the request made by the landowners in the area.
- IV In addition to the plucking team, Sets of machineries for plucking, pruning and holing are to be maintained at the factory for the purpose of renting out for field practices of any other estates in the area.

4. Method of payment of subsidies

The maximum amount of subsidy is Rs.900,000/= per each tea factory

I Subsidy payment for the formation of smart plucking teams is maximum Rs.400,000.00 for the purchase of following items.

1. 10 No's of uniforms	- Rs. 50,000.00
2. 10 No's plucking baskets	- Rs. 25,000.00
3. 07 No's plucking shears	- Rs. 14,000.00
4. 03 No's Battery operated plucking machines	- Rs.276,000.00
5. 10 No's Safety boots	- Rs. 35,000.00
	Rs. 400,000 00

II Machineries for renting out - Each factory is granted 50% of the value of machineries or maximum Rs.500,000.00 as a subsidy payment to purchase and maintain a machinery shed at the factory.

6. 12 No's of plucking shears	- Rs. 12,000.00
7. 03 No's of battery operated plucking machine	- Rs.138,000.00
8. 02 No's of holing machines	- Rs.175,000.00
9. 02 No's of pruning machines	- Rs.175,000.00

- III. On the request of any tea land owner, the plucking team can be employed and reasonable payments are allowed to receive from each field practice. A similar procedure is followed in renting out machineries kept in the factory and transportation of the plucking team and machineries should be arranged by the manufacturer or the team leader of the plucking team or the land owners who request the service. The team of puckers is entitled to receive a higher payment for the service given to tea estates.
- IV. The applicant or the Registered Tea Manufacturers applying for this scheme has to sign a MOU with SLTB and is bound to maintain the machineries and the plucking team in operation minimum 3 years from the date of signing the MOU.
- V. On completion of the team formation and purchasing all machineries and other items mentioned above 4 I and 4 II he/she should inform to the relevant ATC with original Tax invoices requesting subsidy payments.
- VI. Expenses for conducting awareness and training programs for 5 days will be borne by Sri Lanka Tea Board.

5. Terms and conditions of this scheme

- I The selected team of leaf pluckers needs to be given at least 5 days training (40 hours). Theoretical and practical aspects of field practices such as land preparation, tea planting, weeding, application of agrochemicals, leaf plucking and pruning need to be covered. Further the usage of machineries and modern tools have to be incorporated in the training schedule.
- II. The responsibility of machineries and related items given to the team should be taken by the team leader selected among the members and necessary service and repairs are to be carried out by the relevant Registered tea manufacturer.
- III. Registered Tea Manufacturer is responsible to assign an officer to maintain the renting out machineries and employing plucking team on the request of any tea land owner. The details of usage of machineries, field practices carried out, services and repairs of machineries, earning and payments to the plucking team have to be daily updated by the assign officer in the factory level. The team leader of the plucking team is also responsible to maintain daily records according to the specimen formats given.
- IV Total financial subsidy payment is Rs.900,000.00 and the payment is made once the team is trained and purchasing of all machineries and submitted the original invoices.
